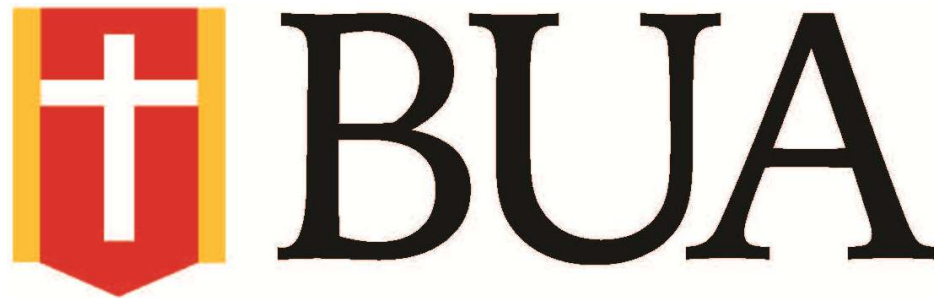

This survey was conducted during the spring semester of 2017 in the month of February.

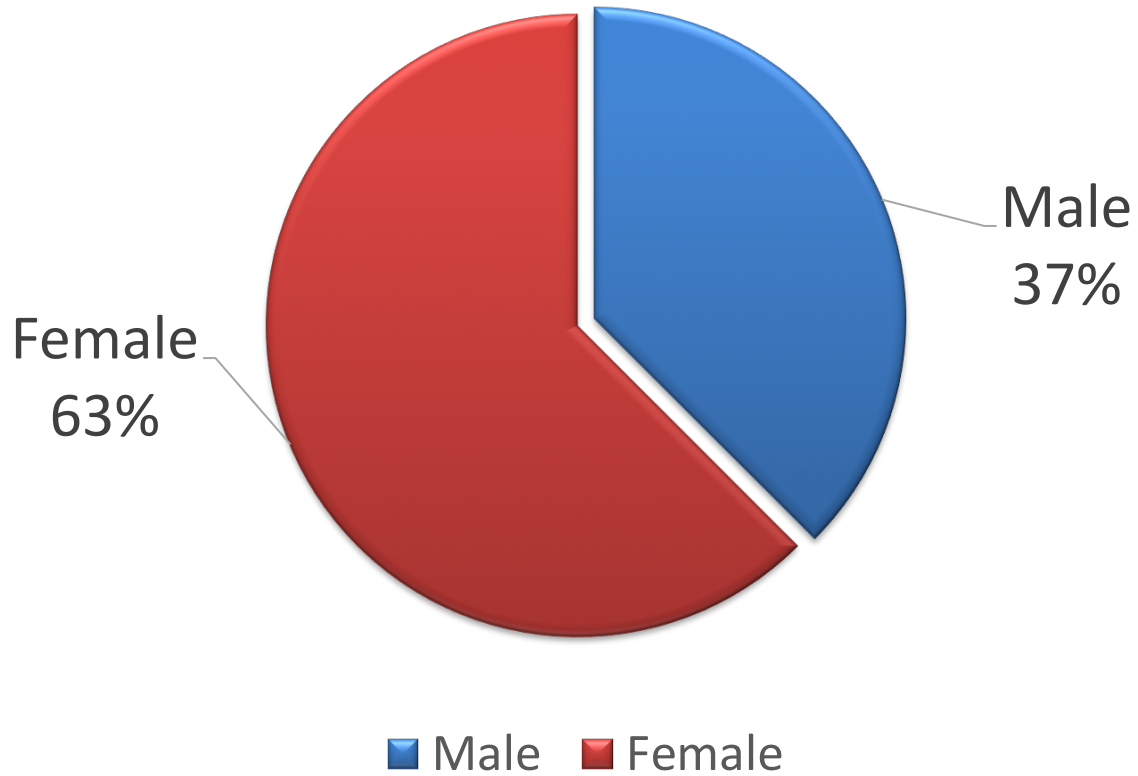
Every student had the opportunity to answer the survey in an anonymous way: students could return it to the I.E. office or hand it in to the I.E. work-study student that assisted with distributing the forms.

From a total of 105 students living at Piper Village, 64 returned the survey, giving us a response rate of 61%.

This survey uses the 5-points Likert scale to provide an evaluation. This is a scale that is represented “0 – 4” (0,1,2,3, and 4), where the higher level of satisfaction corresponds to an evaluation of “4” and the lowest corresponds to “0”.

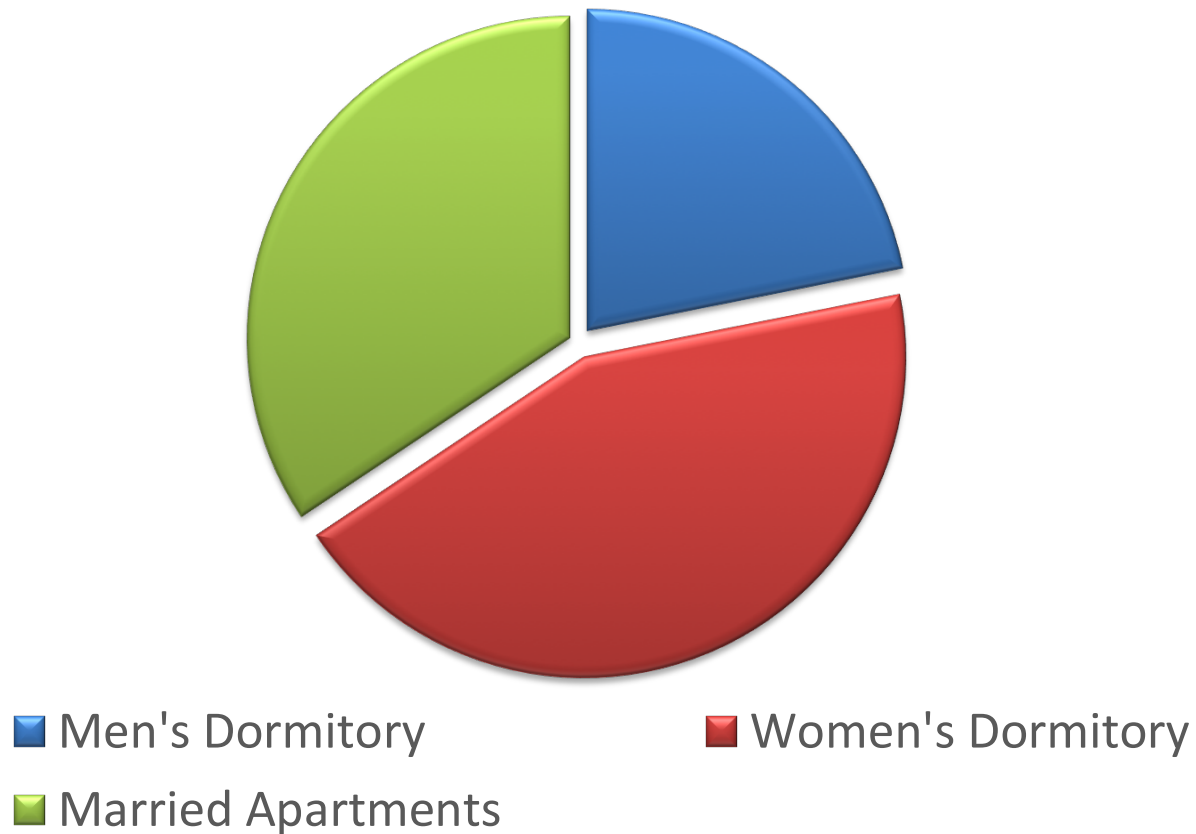

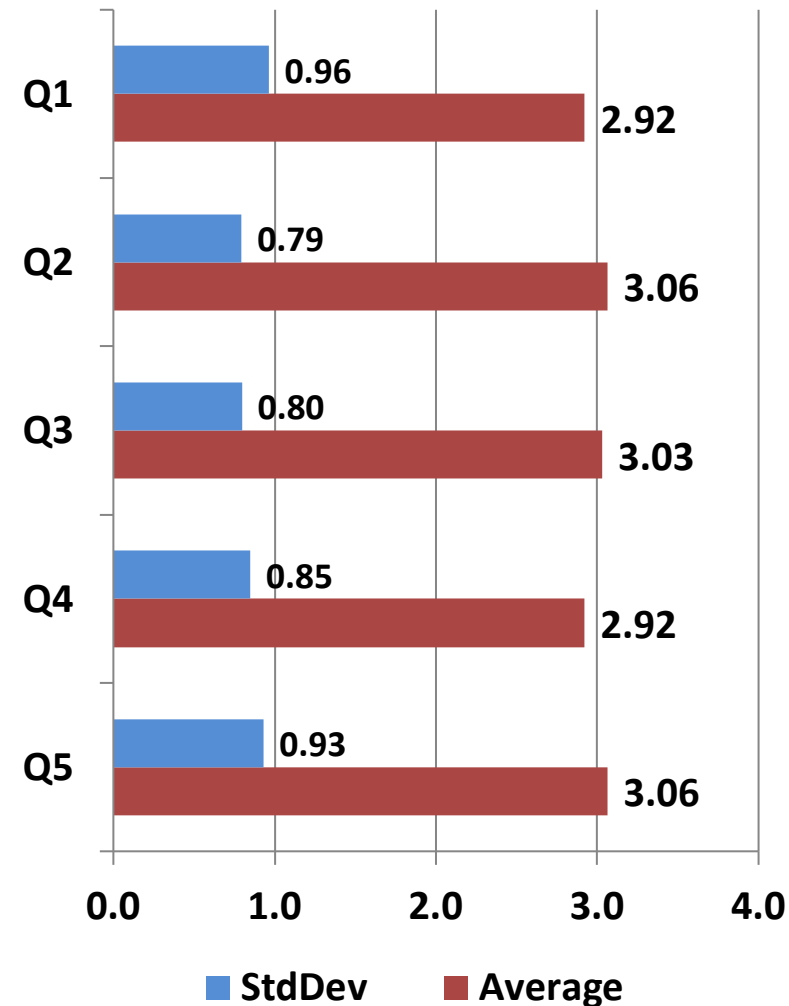
Apartment Section

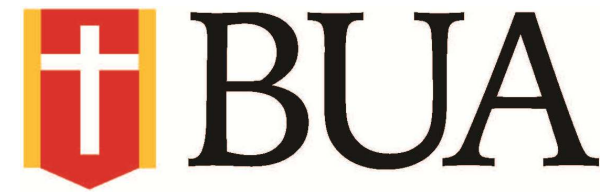

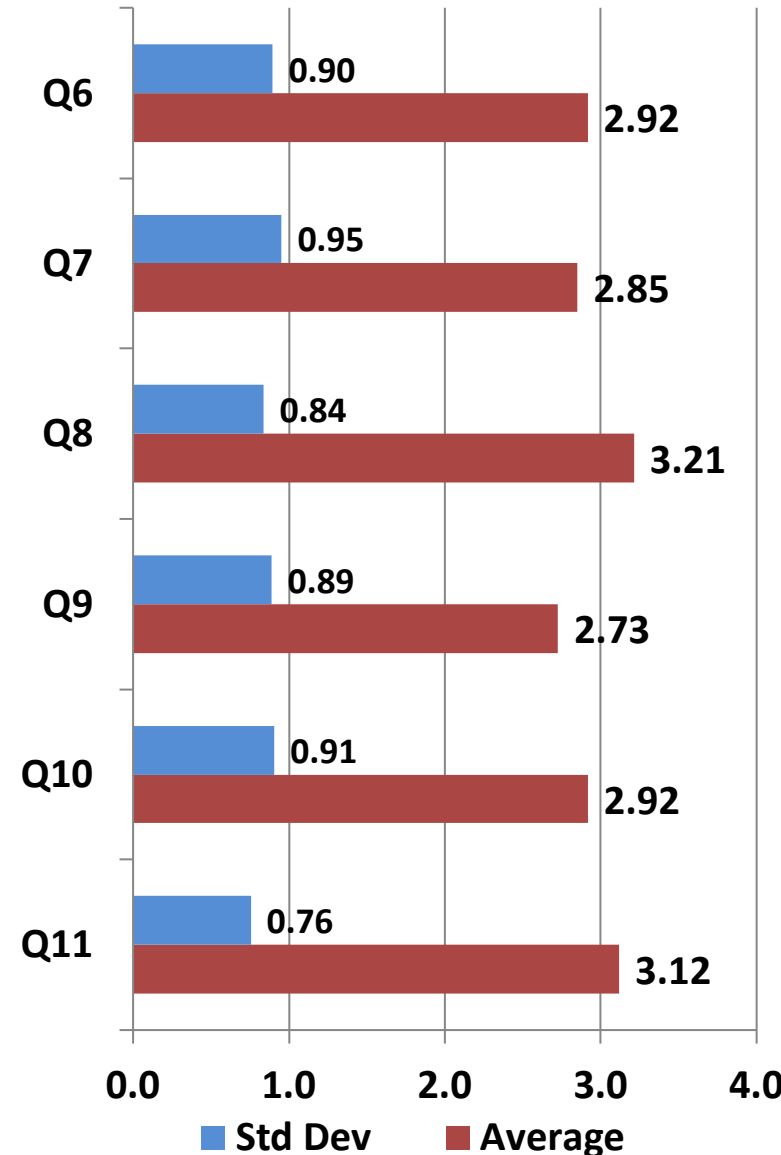

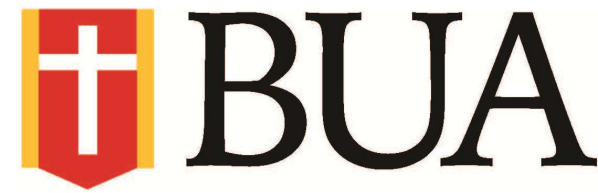
